Eligibility

*Eligible students are those who are entering the second year or higher in their medical imaging education.

* Minimum current GPA: 3.0 [GPA Verification](#)

* You must complete an application, personal profile, and submit essay answers. These forms are included with this invitation.

* You must ask your Program Director to write you a letter of reference to include a statement that you are entering your second year or higher level of education and are in good standing in the program. The letter must be emailed to psrtonline@gmail.com by the deadline.

* Include a copy of your PSRT membership card.

*All application materials must be received by February 29, 2024, completed applications receive past this date will **not** be considered.

The application, copy of your current PSRT membership card, personal profile, essay information, transcripts, and letter of reference. All are requirements for consideration.

- **A statement that you are entering your second year or higher level of education**
- **Confirmation that you are in good standing in your radiography program**
- **Verification of a GPA of 3.0 or higher**
